Using a U.S. atlas as well as the information from the map on page 461, create a map in the space below of the United States around 1900 that depicts the following information: the locations of Ellis Island and Angel Island; those states with immigrant populations of 100,000 or greater, 200,000 or greater, 300,000 or greater, 400,000 or greater, 700,000 or greater, and 1 million or greater. Depict the information in a way that is clear and easy to understand (Shading the states different colors based on their immigrant populations, for example).
